5-2-1: **FREQUENTING POOL AND BILLIARD HALLS:** It is unlawful for any person under the age of eighteen (18) years to go into or frequent at any time any pool or billiard hall, and it is unlawful for any owner or keeper of any pool or billiard hall to permit or suffer any person under the age of eighteen (18) years to enter, remain in or frequent at any time any pool or billiard hall, and any person found guilty of violating the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction thereof, be punishable as provided in subsection 1-4A-1A of this code. (1985 Code § 9.28.010; amd. 2010 Code)

5-2-2: **DISCHARGING FIREARMS:**

- A. It is unlawful for any person under the age of eighteen (18) to fire or discharge an air rifle, air gun, BB gun, 22 caliber rifle, pistol, revolver or any other gun or firearm which is fired or discharged by powder or air compression and discharges lead, shot, pellets and missiles within the corporate limits of the city. (1985 Code § 9.28.020; amd. 2010 Code)
- B. Any person under the age of eighteen (18) found firing or discharging any of the weapons or instruments designated in subsection A of this section, within the corporate limits of the city, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished according to law, and such weapons or instruments described in said subsection A may be seized and confiscated by any member of the county sheriff's department or any other law enforcement officer in the state. (1985 Code § 9.28.030; amd. 2010 Code)

- C. The parents or guardians of any person under the age of eighteen (18) found violating subsection A of this section, where it is established by proper finding that damage to property and injury to persons have been sustained by property owners and persons within the corporate limits of the city, shall be held liable for all damages and injuries sustained. (1985 Code § 9.28.040; amd. 2010 Code)
