

## CHAPTER 1

**GENERAL PROVISIONS**

## SECTION:

- 2-1-1: Authority To Establish Boards, Commissions And Committees
- 2-1-2: Appointments And Removals
- 2-1-3: Compensation
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2-1-1: **AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND COMMITTEES:** The mayor and council shall have authority to appoint such boards, commissions and committees as may be deemed necessary or expedient to assist the mayor and council in better carrying out the responsibilities of their offices. (1985 Code § 2.36.050)

2-1-2: **APPOINTMENTS AND REMOVALS:** All appointments to permanent boards, commissions or committees shall be made by the mayor, with the advice and approval of the council, and members of permanent boards, commissions or committees may, in like manner, be removed. (1985 Code § 2.36.050)

2-1-3: **COMPENSATION:** Members of all boards, commissions or committees shall serve without compensation, but actual and necessary expenses may be allowed by the ordinance creating the board, commission or committee in the case of permanent boards, commissions or committees, or with prior approval of the mayor and city council for all other boards, commissions or committees. (1985 Code § 2.36.050)

2-1-4: **ORGANIZATION AND RECORDS:** Unless otherwise specifically provided, each board, commission or committee shall provide its own manner of organizing but shall maintain such records and make such reports as the mayor and city council may require or request. (1985 Code § 2.36.050)

2-1-5: **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:** The responsibilities, duties and authority granted permanent boards, commissions or committees shall be enumerated by the ordinance creating said board, commission or committee. (1985 Code § 2.36.050)
