

## CHAPTER 6

**MAYOR**

## SECTION:

1-6-1: **QUALIFICATIONS:** Any person shall be eligible to hold the office of mayor who is a qualified elector of the city at the time of his/her declaration of candidacy or declaration of intent is submitted to the city council and remains a qualified elector during his/her term of office. (1985 Code § 2.04.010; amd. 2010 Code)

1-6-2: **ELECTED OFFICIAL; TERM OF OFFICE:** The term of office of the mayor shall be a period of four (4) years, and the first general municipal election at which a mayor shall be elected shall be held on November 7, 1967. (1985 Code § 2.04.020)

1-6-3: **POWERS AND DUTIES:** The mayor shall be the chief administrative official of the city and shall preside over all meetings of the city council and shall possess such powers and discharge such duties as are prescribed by the laws of the state. (1985 Code § 2.04.030)

1-6-4: **COMPENSATION:** The mayor shall receive an annual salary in the sum of nine thousand dollars (\$9,000.00), plus medical insurance consistent with the city employee package. (Ord. 261-05, 1-1-2006)
