

CHAPTER 4

PEDDLERS, SOLICITORS AND TRANSIENT MERCHANTS

SECTION:

- 3-4-1: Vending And Peddling; License Required
3-4-2: Peddling And Soliciting; Invitation Required

3-4-1: **VENDING AND PEDDLING; LICENSE REQUIRED:**

- A. License Required: No person shall expose or offer for sale any article or thing, or station or place any stand, cart or vehicle for the transportation, sale or display of any such article or thing, without first obtaining a city license therefor. (1985 Code § 9.20.080)
- B. Violation; Penalties: It is a misdemeanor for any person to violate this section. Every person convicted of a misdemeanor for a violation of this section shall be punishable as provided in subsection 1-4A-1A of this code. (1985 Code § 9.20.150; amd. 2010 Code)

3-4-2: **PEDDLING AND SOLICITING; INVITATION REQUIRED:**

- A. The practice of going in and upon private residences in the city by peddlers, solicitors, hawkers, itinerant merchants and transient vendors of merchandise, not having been requested or invited to do so by the owner or owners, occupant or occupants of such private residences, for the purpose of soliciting orders for the sale of goods or service, wares and merchandise, and/or for the purpose of disposing of and/or peddling or hawking the same, is declared to be a nuisance and punishable as such nuisance as a misdemeanor. (1985 Code § 9.24.010)
- B. Any person convicted of perpetrating a nuisance as described and prohibited in subsection A of this section, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined as provided in subsection 1-4A-1A of this code, together with costs of proceedings. (1985 Code § 9.24.020; amd. 2010 Code)
