

**MINUTES OF THE CITY OF DRIGGS
SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING
November 11, 2013**

Pursuant to adjournment of the City Council meeting held November 4, 2013, and the call of the Mayor, the Driggs City Council met **Tuesday, November 11, 2013**, at 7:15 p.m. A roll call was taken and present were council members: Greer Jones, Ralph Mossman, George Mosher (via phone), Colin Dye, and Mayor Dan Powers, Public Works Director Jared Gunderson, and City Clerk Kreslyn Schuehler. Mayor Dan Powers led the Pledge of Allegiance.

1MG TANK ALTITUDE VALVE REPLACEMENT PROJECT BIDS – AQUA ENGINEERING

Darin Hawkes, from Aqua Engineering, spoke to the Council. He stated one bid was received from Zollinger Construction in the amount of \$74,250. The engineer estimate was approximately \$50,000 and Mr. Hawkes felt this bid was about 10-20% higher than it should be.

Mr. Hawkes stated that if the Council wanted the project completed this year, the project would not be able to be re-bid due to the climate. He stated he researched removing the solar panel wiring (cost of \$500) and the hatch (cost of \$2,000). However, to do electrical wiring it would cost approximately \$2,500 plus the meter fee and the monthly electrical bill. Mr. Hawkes felt that once the project began and they were about to see the issue, some valves and fittings may be able to be reused, decreasing the cost.

Mayor Powers felt that if the Council waited until the spring, the city would spend the difference in repairs and keeping the system running at a minimum.

Council Member Jones made a motion to approve the bid from Zollinger Construction for the 1MG Tank Altitude Valve Replacement Project. Council Member Mosher seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.

ADJOURNMENT

Council Member Dye made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Jones seconded the above motion. The motion passed with all in favor and the meeting was adjourned at 7:39pm.
