

**MINUTES OF THE CITY OF DRIGGS
SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING
MAY 21, 2013**

Pursuant to adjournment of the City Council meeting held May 7, 2013, and the call of the Mayor, the Driggs City Council met **Tuesday, May 21, 2013**, at 8:00 p.m. A roll call was taken and present were council members: Greer Jones, Ralph Mossman George Mosher, and Colin Dye, Mayor Dan Powers, Community Development Director Doug Self, and City Clerk Kreslyn Schuehler.

RECREATION CENTER IMPROVEMENTS TO NORTH END

Doug Self presented information to the Council. He stated the work that received a bid was for the main dividing wall between Teton Indoor Sports Academy and the Rock Wall Gym, a door to the finished space, work on the changing rooms and electrical work. Plan One's estimate was \$31,000 and the bid from Headwaters Construction came in at \$80,000. After some discussion with Headwaters, the bid was dropped by to \$31,500, Mr. Self stated.

Mr. Self explained that some of the funds for the project had been used for the design so the remainder of funds was \$21,000. Mr. Self recommended that all work be dropped until the fall except for the door to the finished side of the building, which he hoped would be under \$25,000.

Mayor Powers offered to go through the bid and see if the numbers were "reasonable" and then move forward with a decision.

Council Member Dye made a motion to table the bid on Phase IIA of the City Center Master Plan. Council Member Mossman seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.

SCENIC BYWAY CENTER WITH PLAN ONE

Mr. Self stated Idaho Transportation Department approved the Local Professionals Service Agreement which would not exceed \$121,386.00. Subconsultants included were Studio Tectonic, Engineering System Solutions and Sargent Engineers, Inc. A completion date was set for July 2014.

Council Member Dye made a motion to approve the Idaho Transportation Department Local Professional Service Agreement. Council Member Jones seconded the motion.

Council Member Jones questioned when construction would begin. Mr. Self stated it was scheduled to begin in October of 2013.

The above motion passed with all in favor.

BEER AND WINE LICENSES

Council Member Dye made a motion to approve the beer and wine license for Agave and Huntsman Springs. Council Member Mossman seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.

ADJOURNMENT

Council Member Jones made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Mossman seconded the above motion. The motion passed with all in favor and the meeting was adjourned at 8:27pm.
