ACCEPTABLE WASTE

Only inert waste of the type generated by construction and demolition will be accepted, as described in IDAPA 58.01.06.005.19.

Sortable Items:

Concrete
Masonry Block
Metal Wire
Scrap Metal
Metal Pipe
Rock
Cardboard

Wood
Tree Limbs
Untreated posts
Clean Drywall
Uncontaminated soil
Brick

Unsortable items:

PVC pipe
Vinyl siding
Tile
Lumber Ties & wrap
Plumbing Fixtures
Composite shingles

Roofing Paper
Glass (no bottles)

Please make sure to remove all plastic bags before dumping in the Construction pit

PROHIBITED WASTE

Examples of prohibited waste include:

Prohibited Construction Waste

Paint Waste and paint containers
(Wet & Oil based)
Adhesive or adhesive containers
(including used tubes)
Chemicals and chemical containers
(dry or wet)
Wood posts and poles treated with
creosote, arsenic, or similar preservatives
Construction food waste
Asbestos materials

HOUSE HOLD AND OFFICE WASTE

Office or shop waste /Plastic Sheeting
Household refuse and appliances
Furniture /Styrofoam Board
Carpet and Capet pad / Insulation
Paper and Newsprint
Grass clippings

Automotive and Mechanical

Auto bodies and parts
Tires
Used motor oil
Anti freeze
Batteries

Biological Waste

Septage or similar liquids
Manure
Biohazardous Waste

Industrial Waste

Demolition from chemical
and fertilizer supply warehouses
Incinerator trash
Dross
Hazardous Waste
Radioactive Waste
PCB's

While a majority of these items are not allowed in the C.D. pit, most are accepted else where in our facility.
