2-4-1: **CREATED:** A joint Driggs-Teton County planning commission is hereby established pursuant to Idaho Code 67-6526(g) for the sole purpose of reviewing subdivision applications concerning land within the Driggs area of city impact. (Ord. 325-11, 10-4-2011)

2-4-2: **COMPOSITION; APPOINTMENT; QUALIFICATIONS:**

- A. The city planning and zoning commission shall select and maintain three (3) designated sitting members from their commission to serve on the five (5) member joint Driggs-Teton County planning commission. Two (2) of the Driggs members shall be residents of the city of Driggs and the third shall be a resident of the Driggs area of city impact. (Ord. 325-11, 10-4-2011)

2-4-3: **RULES AND ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE:** The general rules of administrative procedure established in title 2 of the Teton County code shall be followed by the joint Driggs-Teton County planning commission. (Ord. 325-11, 10-4-2011)
